

## Geneveve Testimonial

I'm a 70 year old woman, very active, and I have a significant other who is 17 years younger than myself. We've never really had any trouble in that area, I've been lucky. I'm a fairly good size or at least we're a good fit together. I don't have a problem with lubrication, I'm on complete hormone replacement, but I did have a complete hysterectomy where they remove the cervix. I wasn't told beforehand that when they do that you respond differently sexually, unfortunately. I had no problem with it and I would have kept it in but they just took it and didn't tell me I would be different sexually in response. I do respond slower in orgasm than I did before. I didn't even realize I wasn't as sensitive.

When I had this treatment it absolutely was totally comfortable. They insert just a small amount, and rotate with nice conversation in between. It's not as bad as going to the gynecologist with a speculum, it's nothing really. It was painless with a little tingling after. I went online because I noticed 2 days later that the stress incontinence was better. I thought, "Is this my imagination?" I saw testimonials from other women that said they noticed it right away, as did I. Sexually, 4 days later I noticed a big difference. My partner said "OMG is it going to get any tighter?" I said I don't know! He said "Well, I don't think I'd get any larger so I think you got tighter." So, immediately I noticed.
